The annual Christmas Party will be held December 17th following the service. Please sign up in the fellowship hall to provide an appetizer.

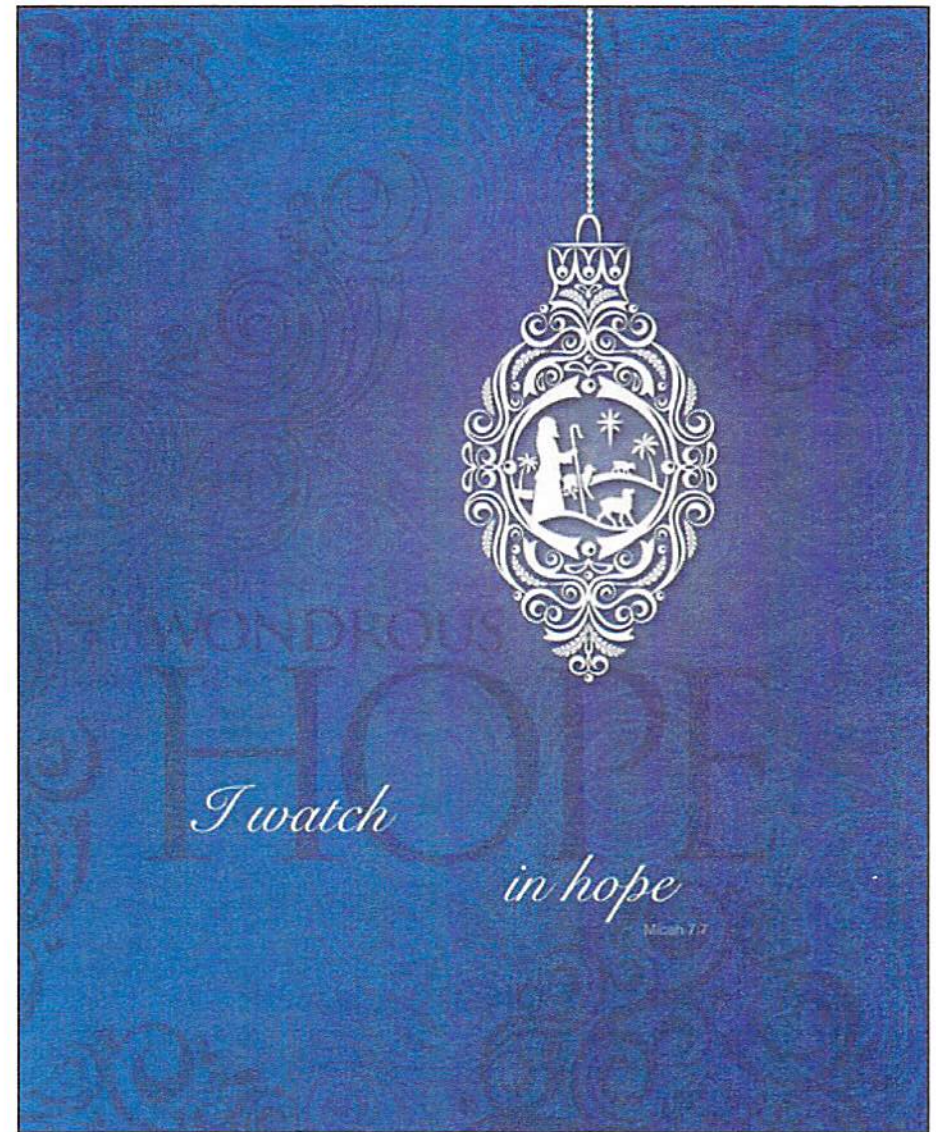
OPERATION KOOL-AIDE
