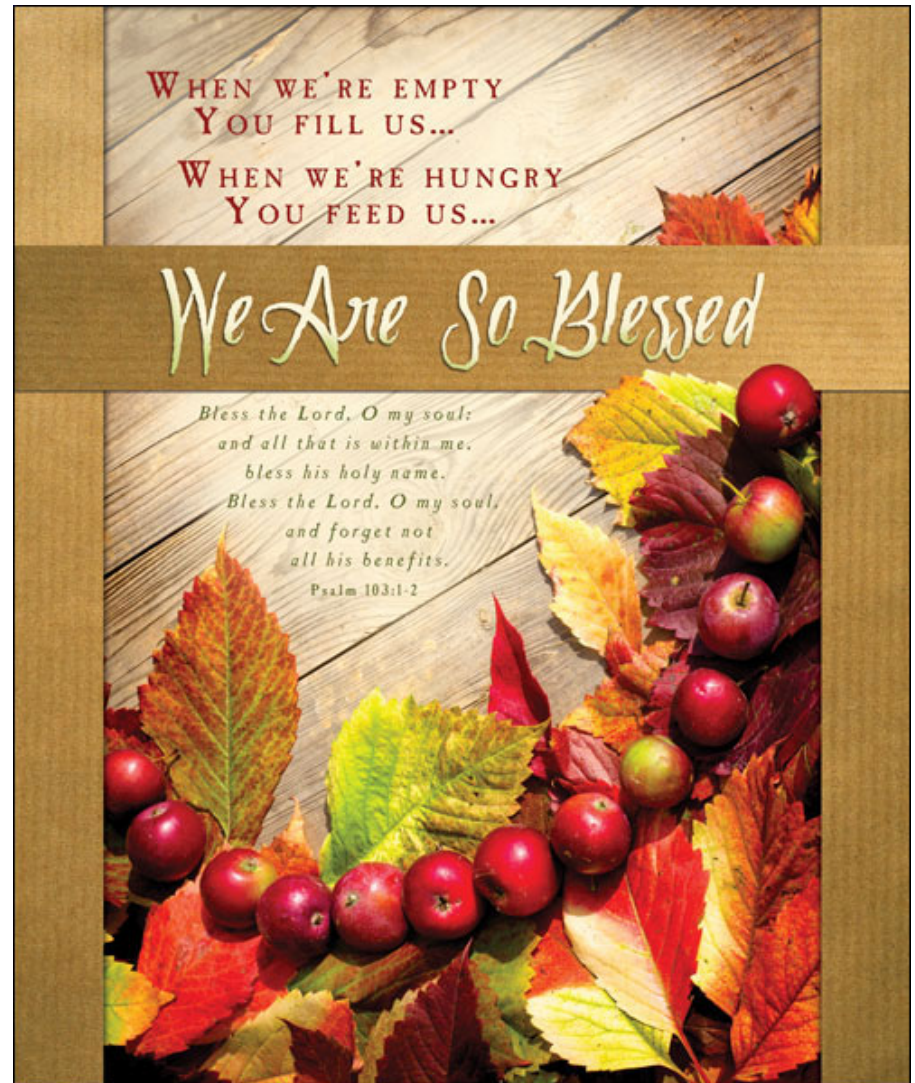
OPERATION KOOL-AIDE
