OPERATION KOOL-AIDE

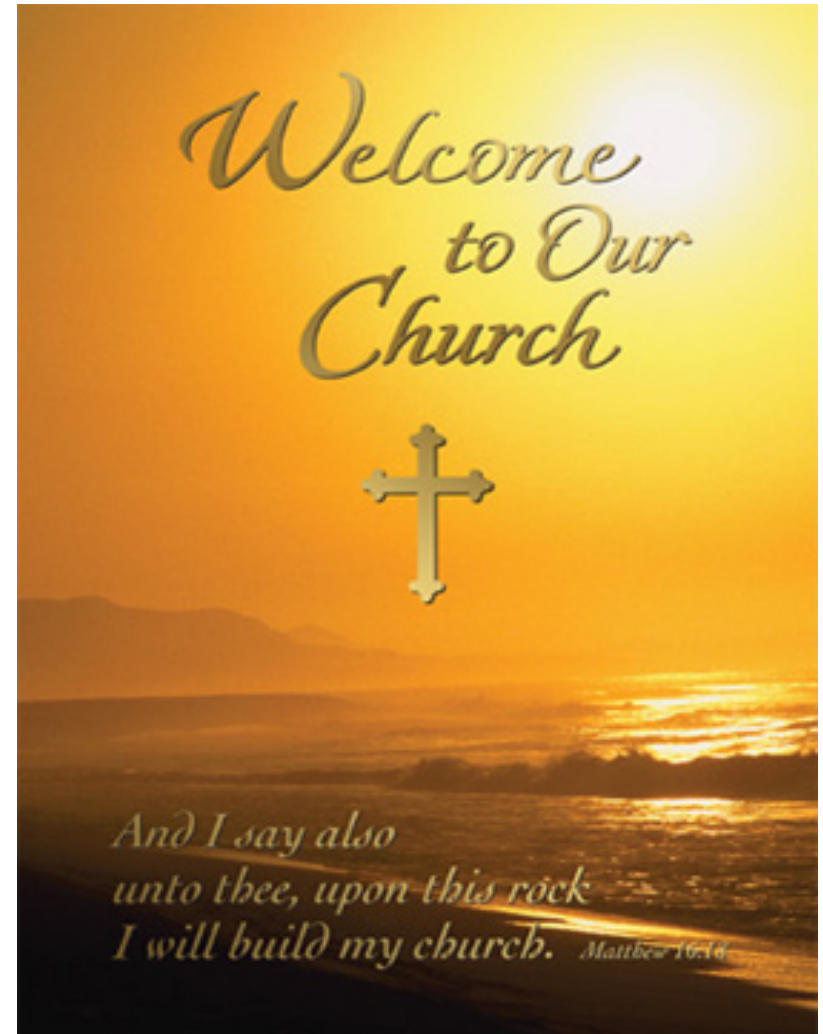
