BELLEVUE FOOD PANTRY NEEDS

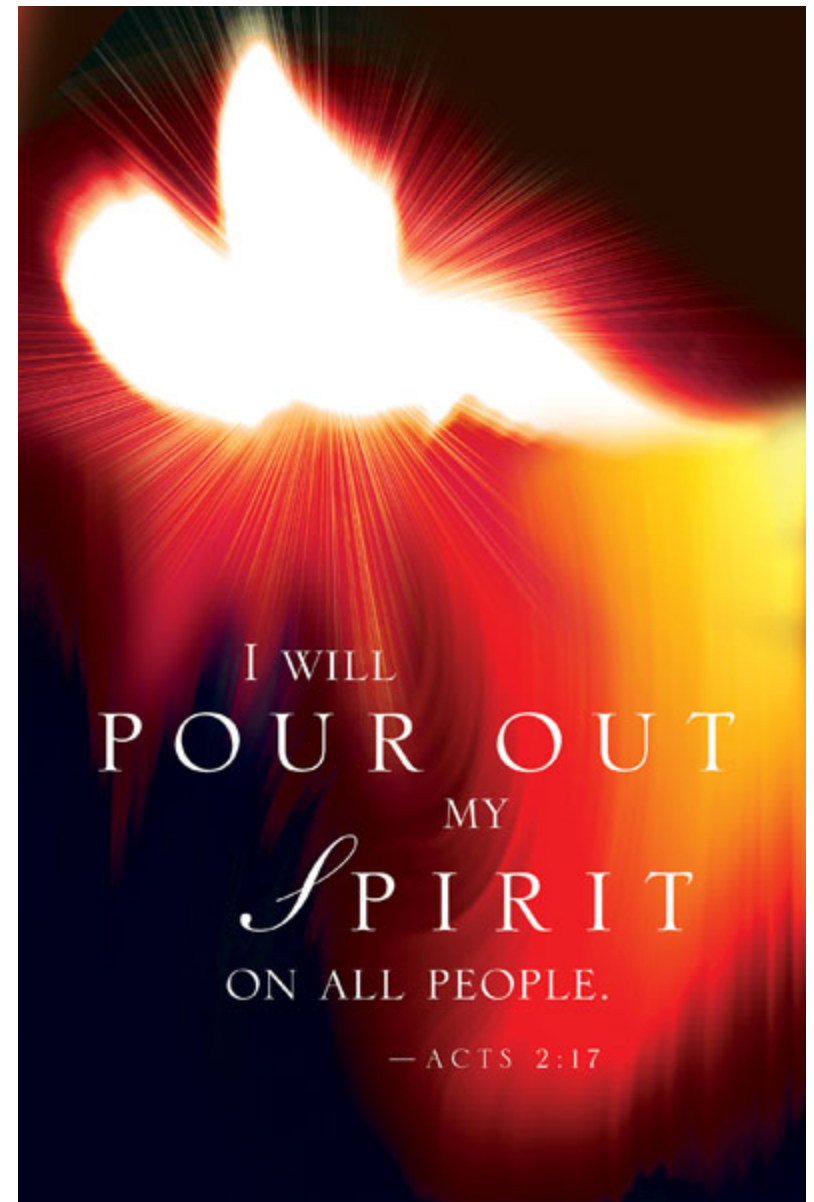
