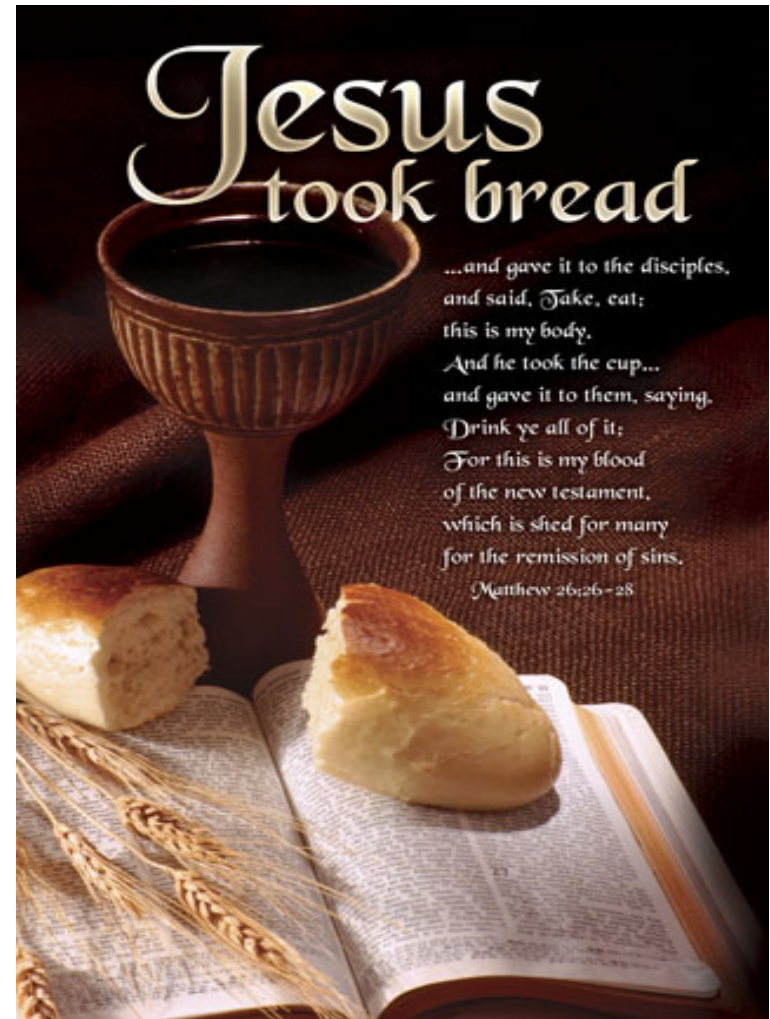
BELLEVUE FOOD PANTRY NEEDS
